The Problem

Though little verifiable data exists, some addiction treatment professionals estimate that the relapse rate of people leaving initial, primary treatment is as high as 80%, with 50% of relapse occurring within the first 30 days.

The Challenge

The challenge is assisting the client to use and implement those skills to make the critical transition from treatment to lifelong recovery.
